3. Notes of Meeting 13	Agreed as written. Email comments from Jenny Shaw re VH were noted.	
4. Actions from Meeting 13	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. PH was still awaiting 50 copies of bus timetables from SCC. They would be distributed and the locations advertised in the BM in due course.</li> <li>2. PH has received payment for the DPA registration.</li> <li>3. The visit to the Army at Wattisham had taken place on 2 November. HW to write notes for BM explaining operation of the base etc re noise and low flying.</li> <li>4. Suffolk ACRE had confirmed use of the funds as proposed. Playford PC's share (£333) was therefore now available to the PC for use on sand/grit bins.  The proposed survey of Lt and Gt Bealings residents to ascertain preference for use of the funding for security lighting or recycling has been complicated by the VH wishing to survey VH users. It was therefore agreed to refer the matter back to Lt Bealings PC to see if it did want a survey carried out. PH would also raise the matter with Gt Bealings PC, which had not expressed a preference for either project.</li> <li>5. PH has considered the information supplied by GB and concluded that cable undergrounding and main sewer connection would only be possible if those concerned paid.  PH had collated the data and passed it to Ofcom, where there was a priority to eliminate 'Not Spots'.</li> <li>6. Broadband: Only 12 returns had been received to the new survey. This was considered insufficient for further action.</li> <li>7.
